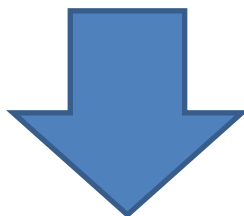

- **WRITING**

  - Theology Essay 1: Explain the following doctrines of salvation. You can use class notes, Demerest, and other sources if needed. Keep long Scripture quotations to a minimum; use mostly references. **3-7 pages single-spaced** (you are welcome to make this as long as you like, but 3 pages minimum)

    - Election
    - Atonement
    - Divine Calling

  - Theology Essay 2: Explain the following doctrines of salvation. You can use class notes, Demerest, and other sources if needed. Keep long Scripture quotations to a minimum; use mostly references. Note that Ryrie’s *Basic Theology* teaches non-Lordship salvation so his would not be a good source for the doctrine of Sanctification unless you are refuting his view. **4-8 pages single spaced** (you are welcome to make this as long as you like, but 4 pages minimum)
    - Regeneration
    - Perseverance
    - Justification
    - Sanctification
    - Union with Christ
    - Glorification
  - **MEN: Leadership Development Short Essay – 1-2 pages single-spaced**
    - From what you have learned so far, write a letter to a young man (even if you are one yourself) about the importance of godly leadership in a man and what this young man should be striving for as a leader.
  - **WOMEN: Maturity Development Short Essay – 1-2 pages single-spaced**
    - From what you have learned so far, write a letter to a young woman (even if you are one yourself) about the importance of the Titus 2 character qualities of a godly woman.
