

- ✓ Greek = Exodos (ΕΞΟΔΟΣ; "Way out, departure"; 19:1 LXX;
 cf. 2 Pet 1:15)

	Introduction to Exodus WHEN Approximately 1406 BC 40 years after the exodus from Egypt 1446 BC = Exodus from Egypt (key date!)

	Introduction to Exodus WHERE Second part of a five-part series Wilderness of Sinai / Plains of Moab		
	 ✓ Israel poised to take the Promised Land ✓ Dates of Exodus events span from Jacob's entrance into Egypt (1876 BC) to the building of the tabernacle (1445 BC) ❖ Chapters 1 – 2 = 400+ years ❖ Chapters 3 – 40 = 2 years

WHY

- $\checkmark~$ This book is the WHAT of God's Kingdom Plan for Israel
- ✓ Exodus is essentially the establishment of Israel's national charter
- ✓ Most succinctly defined in 19:5–6, "A possession among all the peoples ... a kingdom of priests and a holy nation."

To recount to Israel her origin of redemption from exile and to document her national charter as a Kingdom of Priests to represent God to the nations.

HOW—Terminology and Themes

- ✓ Name (1:1; 2:22; 3:13 [YHWH]; 5:23; 6:3, 16; 15:3;17:15; 18:3, 4, etc.)
- ✓ Glory, Honor, Heaviness, Hardening, Strength (6:1; 7:3, 13, 14, 8:15, 19; 9:2, 12, 34, 35; 10:19, 20, 27; 10; 12:33, 38; 13:3, 9, 14, 15, 16; 14:4 (2x), 8, 17 (2x), 18, 25, etc.)
 ✓ Sending (3:10, 12, 14, 15, 20 (2x); 4:4 (2x), 13 (2x), 21, 23 (2x), 28; 5:1, 2 (2x); 6:1, 10; 7:14, 16 (2x), etc.
- Salvation, Deliverance, Rescue, Ransom, Redemption (2:17, 19; 3:8, 22; 5:23 (2x); 6:6 (2x); 8:23; 12:27, 36; 13:13 (3x), 15; 14:13, 30; 15:2, 13, etc.
