Membership Covenant

Having been graciously brought to repentance by the mercy of God, having believed on the Lord Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and having been baptized upon profession of faith, I desire formal membership at Grace Bible Church. Recognizing that the purpose of the church as expressed in Colossians 1:28 is to proclaim Christ and bring his people to obedient maturity in Christ, I covenant to do the following (based primarily on the text of Romans 12:9–21).

Article 1: Authentic Love

I covenant...

- ...to love the body of Christ with a whole heart, without hypocrisy, based on the commonality of the gospel of Christ, to have genuine heart-felt affection for the members and leaders with brotherly affection, endeavoring to outdo one another in showing honor.
- ...to love with a welcoming heart, seeking to show hospitality. I will be welcoming to guests, to friendships old and new, and to the unbeliever in need of the gospel.
- ...to love with a vulnerable heart by rejoicing with those who rejoice and weeping with those who weep. I will endeavor to be real, vulnerable, accessible, and accountable.
- ...to love with a selfless heart, never repaying evil for evil, but seeking what would be honorable in the sight of all. I will place the welfare of the church before my own and seek the good of the whole body.

Article 2: Purposeful Christlikeness

I covenant...

- ...to live in joy, rejoicing in my current and future hope in Christ. I will manifest this in choosing not to complain, in speaking of my hope and joy in the Lord, in deflecting praise for myself and honoring the Lord, and in modeling Christian joy to others.
- ...to suffer in faith, being patient in tribulation. I will endeavor to grow in my trust in God during times of trial and to emulate patiently seeking Christ and finding strength in Him.
- ...to speak in blessing, not using my tongue to tear others down, but rather blessing even those who may persecute me. I will endeavor to think and speak the best of my brothers and sisters in the Lord.
- ...to act in obedience, overcoming evil with good. I will endeavor to live life and make decisions based on the standards of Scripture rather than emotion or personal desires as a reflection of my love for Christ.

Article 3: Enthusiastic Body Life

I covenant...

- ...to attend with enthusiasm, having a zeal to be with the church at every possible opportunity. I will endeavor to take charge of my spiritual growth by constant communion with the church.
- ...to fellowship with enthusiasm, making a conscious decision to be fervent in spirit, thankful for the joy of communion with the saints.
- ...to serve with enthusiasm, using my spiritual gifts for the sake of the church as a fellow servant of Christ, seeking to selflessly meet the needs of the ministry for the sake of the church as a fellow servant of Christ, even if my service is not in my favorite area of ministry.
- ...to pray with enthusiasm, being constant in prayer for the needs and ministries of the church. I will endeavor to do spiritual battle at the throne of grace on behalf of Christ's kingdom as represented in our church.

• ...to give with enthusiasm according to my means, supporting financially the preached word of God, the stewardship of property, special projects of the church, local and global missions, and charitable needs within the church. I will not be selfish by receiving spiritual food without sharing in the material cost.

Article 4: Active Discipleship

I covenant...

- ...to learn with eagerness, taking advantage of the learning and growth opportunities
 available, first and foremost the regular expository preaching presented each week. I
 will endeavor to grow in the knowledge and love of Christ and to deepen my
 understanding of the Word of God and sound doctrine.
- ...to learn with humility, eager to be a disciple of Christ who listens well, respects those who are teaching me, and listens with the goal of personal sanctification rather than critical evaluation.
- ...to learn with worship, focusing the knowledge I am gaining into all that gives more glory to God as I learn of His attributes and His glorious Scripture.

Article 5: Humble Submission

I covenant...

- ...to have a high regard for Scripture, abhorring what is evil and holding fast to what is good. The local church is unified under its doctrinal statement, a reflection and summary of the theology of Scripture. I will live under the doctrinal statement of Grace Bible Church, either in full agreement of without discord in any area I believe differently.
